Hospital Meets Growing Community Need

Wyoming County Community Health System's Board of Managers is pleased to announce the approval of final plans to renovate its physical plant that will accommodate the growing needs for outpatient, surgical, rehabilitation, and long-term care services.

"As a major health care provider in the county and one of the area's leading employers, it is imperative that we continue to offer high-quality medical care that is available close to home," says Ronald J. Krawiec, CEO of the health system.

Mr. Krawiec further explained, "We have state-of-the-art technology, such as digital imaging, digital mammography, ultrasound, nuclear medicine, DEXA Scanner (for testing bone density), MRI, and CT scan, that is difficult to house in a 55+ year old building. Our building needs to keep pace with the wide range of services we offer to meet the expectations of our community. The construction of a new Emergency Department, adjacent imaging suite and surgical unit will provide a better all-around experience for our patients."

Highlights of the plans include:

- A wheelchair "friendly" main entrance
- Improved accessibility to emergency care for patients and ambulance services
- Improved outpatient, staff and visitor-service flow
- Improved accessibility between Registration and Emergency, Radiology, and Laboratory Services
- More spacious and private ambulatory services, operating rooms and recovery areas that provide greater patient comfort and privacy
- Updated maternity rooms to make the birthing experience more personal and comfortable for expectant parents
- Electronic medical records with an updated computer system
