About the Thiel Hospitality House

The Thiel Hospitality House is operated by the Western New York Rural Area Health Education Center, Inc. (R-AHEC). Seed money for the construction was provided by the Community Foundation of Greater Buffalo, William F. Thiel Trust Fund.

The Thiel Hospitality House, which opened in 2005, is located on the hill behind the Wyoming County Community Hospital in Warsaw, NY and is adjacent to the R-AHEC Learning Center, our headquarters.

The main objective of the Thiel Hospitality house is to provide affordable housing to health profession students completing rural clinical rotations, on-call or visiting medical professionals and families facing a health care crisis.

Directions

NYS Thruway (I-90) or From the North (Route 19):

Exit at LeRoy (exit #47) and take Route 19 and head south to Warsaw (est. 22 miles). Turn left onto Duncan St. (Wyoming County Community Hospital) is on corner), take your second right (behind the hospital) and follow signs to the R-AHEC Thiel Center on hill.

North or South (Route 19):

Take Route 19 to Warsaw and turn onto Duncan St. (Wyoming County Community Hospital) is on corner, take your second right (behind the hospital) and follow signs to the R-AHEC Thiel Center on hill.

East or West (Route 20A):

Take Route 20A into Warsaw. At the intersection of Route 20A and Route 19 – take Route 19 North about 1 mile to stoplight at WCCH hospital; turn onto Duncan St. (Wyoming County Community Hospital on corner), take your second right (behind the hospital) and follow signs to the R-AHEC Thiel Center on hill.
